INVITATION TO COMPETE IN 42nd YARE NAVIGATION RACE

We should like to invite you to this year's Yare Navigation Race on Saturday 16 September 2017. This will follow the Cecil Howard Memorial Race held on Sunday 10 September, when moorings will be available next to our sailing club's moorings with the kind permission of Coldham Hall Tavern.

The race is open to Traditional Broads Sailing Cruisers. The handicaps of competing cruisers, as determined by the River Cruiser Class, will be published in the Race Programme. Cruisers with a provisional handicap may enter the race, shall be timed, but shall not be given any position. Cruisers not conforming to RCC rules on construction, will be treated in the same way as cruisers with a provisional handicap.

The race will start from 8.30 am at Coldham Hall, proceeding to a mark on Breydon Water and then returning to Coldham Hall. Competitors will choose their time to start having considered the tide-timetable, wind speed and direction and factors relevant to the boat and crew.
