Invitation to compete in the 48th Yare Navigation Race on Saturday 14th September 2024

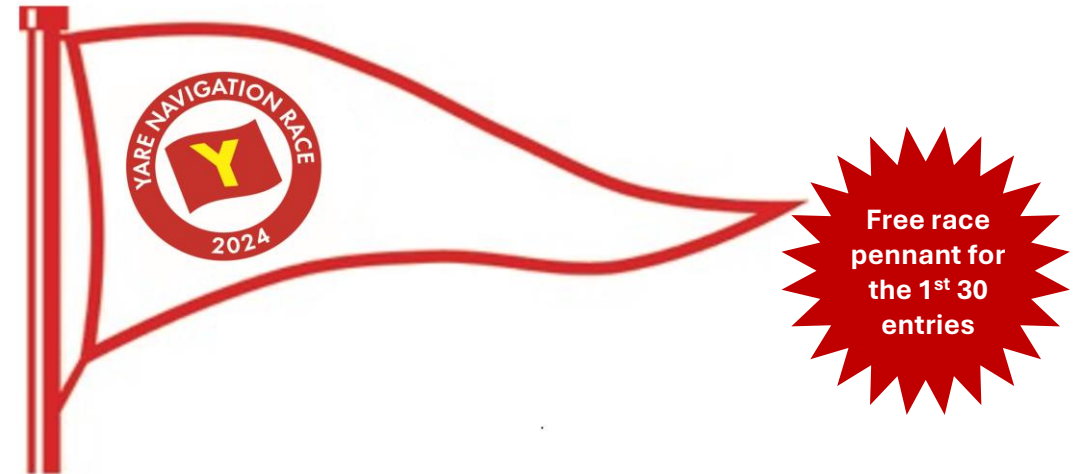
This will follow the Cecil Howard Memorial Race held on Sunday 8th September.

Yare Navigation Race 2024

The Yare Navigation Race is pleased to be part of the Yare Autumn Cruiser Series

Race Entry Form

The race is open to traditional broads sailing cruisers. The handicap of competing cruisers, as determined by the River Cruiser Class (RCC), will be published in the race programme. Cruisers not registered with the RCC but conforming with RCC rules, will be allocated a provisional handicap. Cruisers with a provisional handicap may enter the race, shall be timed, but shall not be given any position. Cruisers not conforming to RCC rules on construction, will be allocated a handicap and will be treated in the same way as Cruisers with a provisional handicap.

The race will open for starts from 08.30 at the Coldham Hall Sailing Club start line to a mark on Breydon Water or on the River Yare and then returning to the start line. Competitors will be advised of the course shortening at least 24 hours prior to the race start. Competitors will choose their own start time having considered all relevant race factors for the boat and crew. An assistance boat will be situated at Reedham bridge.
